PRESENTATION MODALITIES

- Oral presentations will be by invitation only for national and international researchers and producers.

- Contributed presentations will be in the form of an electronic poster (E-Poster) and a short video (max. 5 minutes) explaining the research.
- A single author may submit a maximum of two abstracts as the primary author.
- A certificate of presentation will be awarded to the presenting author, listing all coauthors in the submitted order.
- A certificate of attendance will be issued electronically to all registered participants 10 days after the symposium.

ELECTRONIC POSTER (E-POSTER) GUIDELINES

- Accepted abstracts must be presented in an electronic poster (E-Poster)format.
- Abstracts must be original, complete researchthat has not been accepted for publication in journals.
- Posters may be in Spanish or English, and presentations can be in either language.

Abstracts must be submitted electronically through the participant registration webpage before July 15, 2025.
